

## FRC's Blog: From the Forefront

"FRC and its staff helped give a little girl who had nothing, everything, and me, the gift of motherhood and for that we will be forever grateful. Thank you FRC, our family." Annie Argenal



"On May 15th, I got an email, asking me if I would be interested in fostering a 3-day old little girl, no promises were made but I was told that the case looked good for Termination of Parental Rights based on the mother's prior history with the Department of Children and Families. The weekend came and went and by Tuesday I was advised that she would be arriving to my home by 5pm. I rushed home to meet her, there she was! I told myself not to fall in love, but it was too late.

Fast forward to the first court hearing and both parents showed up. I was devastated but **Lourdes Pons**, *FRC's COO*, and **Jessica Harrison**, *FRC's Staff Attorney and Permanency Specialist*, took the time to speak with me and told me to sit tight, to give it time; I did.

Home visits, Guardian Ad Litem visits, court hearings, e-mails and telephone calls ... everything started falling into place. The biological mom was TPR'd, DNA proved that the father wasn't the father and 30 days stood between my little girl and me. Final adoption was set for October 10, 2014 two days after Final Judgment. FRC and its staff helped give a little girl who had nothing, everything. And me, the gift of motherhood, and for that we will be forever grateful. Thank you FRC, our family."
